Quick Start – Test Show

If you want to test a show (test the system), do as follows:

- 1. Program a POD with standard output 1-16 (output 1 = Fire-channel 1, output 2 = fire-channel 2 e.t.c.)
- Start-up the system and attach the POD.
 Make sure that no other POD is connected and that no e-matches is inserted!
- 3. Open the show you want to test.
- 4. Turn of the Safety-key and ARM the system and check that the POD is armed.
- 5. Start the Show (Pressing Fire or Play)
- 6. The relays of POD16 shall click the 15 first seconds (ones per second)!
- 7. Press stop and Disarm.

If not working as expected, check the following things.

- POD will not ARM:
 - Check that Safety-key is turned to ON.
 - If Safety-key are OK, restart the system by turn it off completely for about 10 seconds.
- POD will not Fire:
 - If Time-Code is enabled but not syncronized to any incoming time-code the system will not fire untill a syncronization has been established. Turn of time-code if not used!
 - Fire-button must be pressed. The system requires that the Fire-Button is pressed during the show. Check Settings to disable this.

Quick Start – Test Music/Time-Code

If you want to test the music output and/or Time-Code input, do as follows:

- 1. Connect Audio and Time-Code.
- 2. Start-up the system. (Safety-key OFF)
- 3. Load the Show.
- 4. Press PLAY to start the music.
- 5. Check that the music plays (and Time-code is syncronized if available).
